JACKSON PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD POLICY IDFA: SPEECH LANGUAGE SCREENING

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the district complies with all requirements of the Mississippi Speechanguage Therapy Scholarship for Students with Sphenguage Impairments provided in Mississippi House Bill 896 gislative Session 2013.

II. PROCEDURES FOR SCREENING

In accordance with Mississippi House Bill 896, Jackson Public Schistric will ensure that students will be screened for articulation, language, voice, and fluency disorders before the end of Grade 1.

- If a student fails the screener, the parent or legal guardian will be notified of the results of the screener.
- If a student fails the screener, the school district, in its discretion, may perform a comprehensive speethinguage evaluation.

III. SUBSEQUENT EVALUATION

If a parent or legal guardian of a student who fails the spleaguage screener exercises the option to have a subsequent evaluation performed, such evaluation shall be administered by a 215 endorsed speedanguage pathologist. The subsequent evaluation obtained by the parents
