I. Procedures for Assessing Students for Dyslexia

In accordance with Mississippi Code Annotated Section 733745, the Jackson Public School District will administer a dyslexia screening instrument to each student insoftant the regarden and 1. Students shall be screened in

If, on the basis of the screening instrument results, a student is determined to need further evaluation, the student's parent/guardian will be notified. The District, in its discretion, may perform subsequent dyslexia evaluations administered by licensed professionals, including: psychologists, licensed under Chapter 31, Title 73, Mississippi Code of 1972; psychometrists, licensed by the Mississippi Department of Eation; or Speech Language Pathologists, licensed under Chapter 38, Title 73, Mississippi Code of 1972.
