DUAL ENROLLMENT - DUAL CREDIT

The Board of Trustees of the Jackson Public School District recognizes that dual enrollment of qualified high school scholars in high school and Mississippi public institutions of higher learning is a worthy endeavor. The Mississippi Legislature amended Miss. Code Ann. §37-101-15 to provide that state institutions of higher learning may establish dual enrollment programs for qualified high school scholars and shall enter into an articulation agreement to fully recognize credit received by such scholars.

Dual Enrollment Credit

Eligible scholars may participate in the dual enrollment program established by this school district in compliance with the Mississippi Code of 1972, Section 37- 15-38. Additionally, the District will follow eligibility guidelines as outlined in the "Procedures Manual for the State of Mississippi Dual Enrollment and Accelerated Programs.

- (a) A dual enrolled scholar is a scholar who is enrolled in a community or junior college or state institution of higher learning while enrolled in high school.
- (b) A dual credit scholar is a scholar who is enrolled in a community or jp(Q (8400.. 400.27 Tm

enrolled high school scholar shall be allowed to earn an unlimited number of college or university credits for dual credit.
