

CREDIT RECOVERY POLICY

The purpose of the credit recovery policy is to guide the Board of Trustees and District personnel in the implementation of the Jackson Public School District's credit recovery program. Credit recovery allows scholars who have been unsuccessful in mastering particular content or skills an opportunity to apply for credit recovery as an alternative to repeating the entire course.

- g. Scholars shall not remain in the same credit recovery course for more than one year. One year is defined by the District's calendar.
- h. A middle school or high school scholar with principal approval and parental consent, can earn credit in courses previously failed. More than one course may be taken during the school year. Courses taken for credit recovery must be completed successfully at least two weeks before the last day of the school year. All credit recovery coursework must be completed under the supervision of personnel designated by the school principal.
- i. Beginning in school year, 2024-2025, the district shall only make credit recovery available to scholars within a calendar year from which the scholar fails the course.

Credit Recovery Program Instruction

- i. The method of instruction will be determined by the school, middle school or high school based on available resources and may include, but are not limited to, use of an online, computer program, the Mississippi Virtual Public School, an online or paper-based correspondence program, direct instruction by a highly qualified teacher or another instructional delivery system (iuc)9.2 (t)-w but-

in the course objectives that have not been mastered. Upon successful demonstration of mastery of these objectives, the scholar receives credit for the course.

Credit Recovery Program Grades

- p. The District shall establish specific procedures for the evaluation of scholar progress and determining grades.
- q. Beginning with the school year 2016-17, a scholar who selects credit recovery earn a Carnegie unit(s) may only earn the minimum passing grade on the district's grading scale. The credit recovery grade shall be recorded upon completion of the course. The credit recovery grade shall replace the previous failing course grade.
