

This is a collection of resources to support remote English Language Development instruction while students are unable to receive face-to-face instruction. Several of these are designed to make content available in Spanish. When using this resource, we recommend that students be encouraged when possible to review materials side-by-side, with translations in both English and Spanish. For parents who only speak and read in Spanish, however, there is value in continuing academic content support in the native language during an extended school break.

[BrainPOP ELL](#) is BrainPOP's English language instruction site for English Language Learners of all ages. The curriculum is comprised of short, animated movies as well as games, quizzes and interactive features. Users practice the four principle language domains: listening, speaking, reading and writing. Note: BrainPOP also is available in French and Spanish. This may be helpful to families seeking to support their students in their native language.
